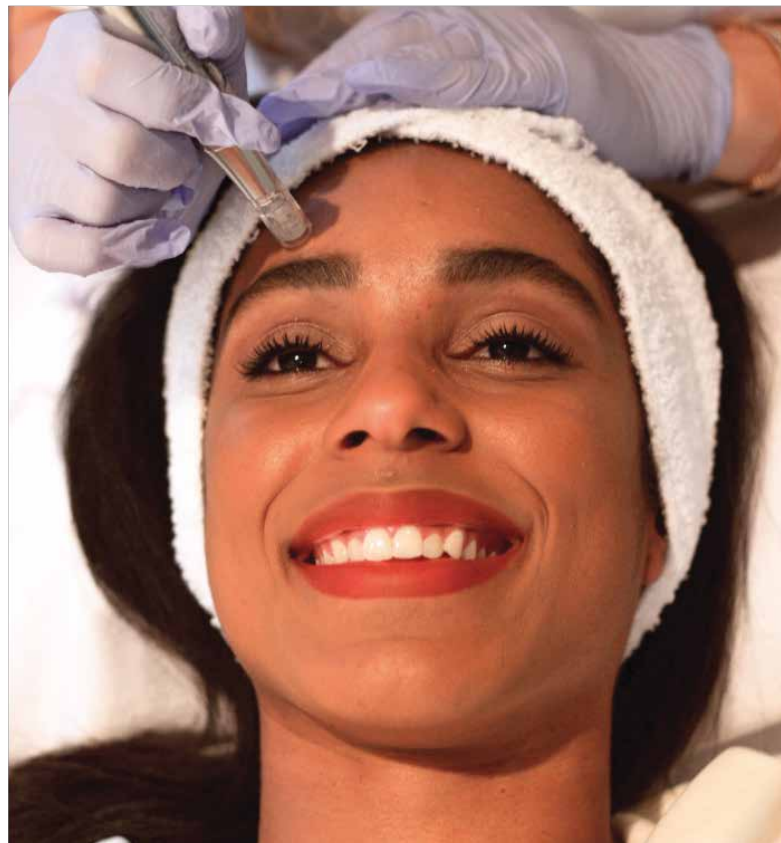
## THE ROLE OF BOTULINUM TOXIN AND DERMAL FILLERS IN SKIN REJUVENATION
